Wine

Like man's best friend, Merlot has that straightforward, easy-going generosity that makes it so likeable. We bottled that charming personality in a mediumbodied, velvety wine brimming with ripe plum and juicy black cherry. The palate is supple and smooth with succulent cherry-berry middle and lasting tannins. Oak aging lends a hint of warm spices and structure. This is a great wine for gathering with friends or pairing with food. Serve it alongside lamb ragout, mushroom risotto or even a chocolate dessert.

Vineyard

Grapes for our Merlot come from vineyards throughout California, which are known for its warm, sun-filled days and cool, maritime breezes in the evenings. This dry Mediterranean climate enables the grapes to develop full, ripe flavors during the day while retaining fine balancing acids from nighttime cooling. To further the intensity of the flavors, winemakers carefully monitor vines, ensuring the grapes develop full, ripe flavors and mature tannins before harvesting.

Winemaking

Our Merlot is crafted to be approachable and friendly, expressing the rich character of the varietal. Following harvest, the grapes were de-stemmed, crushed and placed into temperature controlled stainless steel for fermentation. During this time, we maintained good contact between the juice and skins with regular pump-over, fully extracting and incorporating the aromas and flavors of the fruit. The wine was then aged for seven months with a combination of American and French oak.

Winemaker
